Mr. Albert Reynolds

Following representations made to the Tribunal to the effect that Mr. Albert Reynolds is medically unfit to give further evidence to the Tribunal which is based upon the medical assessments of Mr. Reynolds by his General Practitioner and two medical consultants, the Tribunal engaged its own two medical consultants to conduct independent medical examinations of Mr. Reynolds.

Having been presented with detailed information from the five medical experts, including the two Consultants engaged by the Tribunal and their, essentially, unanimous opinion that Mr. Reynolds has a significant cognitive impairment which renders him medically unfit to give evidence to this Tribunal at this time or within the foreseeable future, the Tribunal has decided that he will not be called to give evidence in the current Module, Quarryvale II.

The Tribunal has decided to reserve to itself the right to review this decision in the event that it receives information which might suggest a change or improvement in Mr. Reynolds' medical condition.
